

net4society is a network of National Contact Points for Socio – economic Sciences and Humanities (SSH) in the European Commission's 7th Framework Programme



The objective of the SSH NCP Best Practice Handbook is to give all SSH NCPs a tool to help improve the quality of their work procedures in regard to NCP support services and information activities, as laid out in the FP7 "NCP Guiding Principles."

The handbook will give concrete, easy-to-follow best practice examples, in order to facilitate the adaptation into actual NCP working procedures, a detailed description of best practice in the areas of information and awareness raising as well as consulting, assistance and training.





On-the-job training / mentoring visits

- Mentor Mentee Relationship = Mentorship
- Mentorship refers to a developmental relationship between a more experienced mentor offering guidance to a less experienced partner (mentee).
- In Net4Society each participant brings in different experiences and knowledge, therefore the lines between mentor and mentee are often blurred. Nevertheless each Mentor in this project has several years relevant work experience.
- 18 Mentoring Visits will be organised in NET4SOCIETY, each lasting for 3 days.
- The first 6 mentoring visits organized in 2008, were regarded very highly by both the mentees and the mentors




